## REP. JUSTIN J. PEARSON, STAND FOR CHILDREN, MEMPHIS FOR ALL, AND PEOPLE FOR FAIRNESS AND JUSTICE ENDORSE VAN TURNER FOR MAYOR OF MEMPHIS

**MEMPHIS, TN** – Today, Representative Justin J. Pearson, Stand for Children, Memphis for All, and the People for Fairness and Justice (PFJ) announced their endorsement of Van Turner for Mayor of Memphis in the pivotal 2023 city election.

During his service as Shelby County Democratic Party Chair, Memphis NAACP President, and Shelby County Commissioner, Turner has demonstrated a commitment to stand with the people of Memphis. Turner has consistently shown that he will fight for Memphis, working alongside grassroots organizations and the most impacted communities to bring about the change we need to move Memphis forward.
